



SUSPECT

FLAGGED

Suspense of all favorable actions including but not limited to: promotions, awards, schools, voluntary transfers, and re-enlistment. The flag remains in effect for the duration of the investigation.

ADVERSE MILITARY ADMIN ACTIONS

If substantiated through local law enforcement and/ or the Office of Complex Investigations (OCI), in addition to possible discharge from the military, the perpetrator could face a reduction in rank, loss of pay, loss of benefits, loss of AGR or FEDTECH positions and/or other unfavorable actions.

CRIMINAL PROSECUTION

If found guilty through civilian law enforcement, the perpetrator could face possible prison sentence, fines, probation, forced to register as a sex offender, and other civil penalties.

Guilty verdicts may also result in discharge from the military

DEFENSE SERVICES

Trial defense services (ARNG) and Airmen
Defense Counsel (ANG) are provided to give
counsel and representation for military
matters (flags and adverse military admin
actions).
