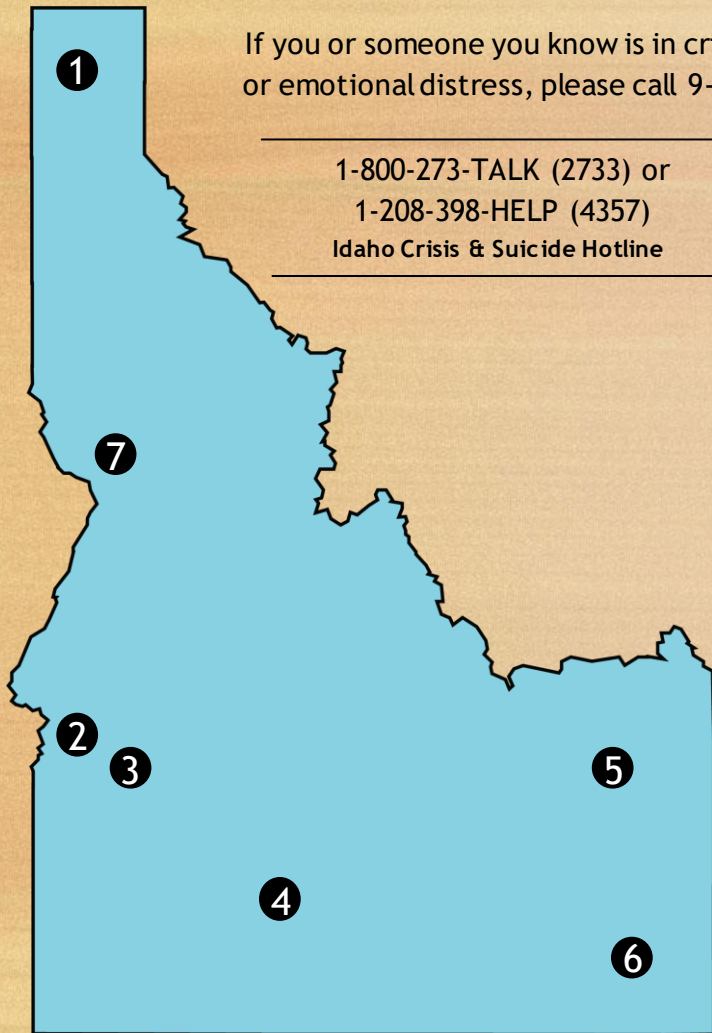


# IDAHO CRISIS CENTERS
