<u>CRITICAL RESPONSE</u> <u>STEPS</u>

- 1. Ensure the survivor's and your own safety.
- 2. Get medical aid if needed for any injuries.
- 3. Contact the SARC or Victim Advocate.
- 4. Protect the Survivor's options and privacy.

SEXUAL ASSAULT REPORTING OPTIONS

Unrestricted

- Medical, advocacy, legal, and counseling services are available.
- Chain of Command with a legitimate need to know and local law enforcement are notified.
- Eligible for an expedited transfer, military and/or civilian protective orders.
- Confidential LOD determination.
- Cannot be changed to a restricted report.

Restricted

- Medical, advocacy, legal, and counseling services are available.
- No criminal investigation.
- Confidential LOD determination.
- Survivor may choose to change to unrestricted at any time.
- Available to any survivor who has not directly reported to law enforcement.
