CRITICAL RESPONSE **STEPS**

1. Ensure the survivor's and your own safety.
2. Get medical aid if needed for any injuries.
3. Contact the SARC or Victim Advocate.
4. Protect the Survivor's options and privacy.

SEXUAL ASSAULT REPORTING OPTIONS

Unrestricted

- Medical, advocacy, legal, and counseling services are available.
- Chain of Command with a legitimate need to know and local law enforcement are notified.
- Eligible for an expedited transfer, military and/or civilian protective orders.
- Confidential LOD determination.
- Cannot be changed to a restricted report.

Restricted

- Medical, advocacy, legal, and counseling services are available.
- No criminal investigation.
- Confidential LOD determination.
- Survivor may choose to change to unrestricted at any time.
- Available to any survivor who has not directly reported to law enforcement.
